

VILLAGE OF NEHAWKA RESOLUTION 2021-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF NEHAWKA  
SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1601.02 provides that the Governing Body of the Village of Nehawka passes by majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request.

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Nehawka, by a majority vote, resolves that:

1. The 2021-2022 property tax request be set at \$36,865.00.
2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 1%.
3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$.428729 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. The Village of Nehawka proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$.434683 per \$100 of assessed value.
5. Based on the proposed property tax request and change in other revenue, the total operating budget of the Village of Nehawka will be more than last year's by 26%.
6. A copy of this resolution is to be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk as part of the Village's budget on or before October 13, 2021.
7. The 2020 budget, as a whole, is approved including budgeted expenditures of \$292,000.00.
