

VILLAGE OF NEHAWKA RESOLUTION 2024-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF NEHAWKA SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statutes 77-1632 and 77-1633 provides that the Governing Body of the Village of Nehawka passes by majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Nehawka, by a majority vote, resolves that:

- 1. The 2024-2025 property tax request be set at \$42,871.47 (General Fund).
2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 0%.
3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be .450859 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. The Village of Nehawka proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$.418025 per \$100 of assessed value.
5. Based on the proposed property tax request and change in other revenue, the total operating budget of the Village of Nehawka will be less than last year's by -34%.
6. A copy of this resolution is to be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2024.
7. The 2024-2025 budget, as a whole, is approved including budgeted disbursements and transfers of \$360,000.00.
